Item Submission Instructions

1. Each quilt requires a separate entry form
2. Judged entries: Entry fee is \$10 per quilt
3. Display Only quilts: No fee required

Hand Delivered Entries

Hand delivered items with a permanent identification on the back will only be accepted at the Memorial Coliseum on Tuesday, August 10, 2010, beginning at 7 am and no later than 9 am.

Shipped Entries

Shipping instructions will be sent via EMAIL if you have included your email address.

Include a self-addressed stamped business-size envelope (SASE) if you wish to receive shipping instructions via US mail.

Critical Dates

July 1, 2010	Entry deadline. Entry forms cannot be postmarked later than this date.
July 28, 2010	Shipped entries must arrive at receiving site.
August 10, 2010	Hand-delivered entries will be received at the Memorial Coliseum only on this date, beginning at 7 am and no later than 9 am.
August 14, 2010	All hand-delivered entries are to be picked up after the Quilt Show on Saturday, August 14, between 5 pm and 7 pm. Identification is required.
