Sizes

Pieced- no larger than 108" on any side

Appliqué- no larger than 108" on any side

Art Quilt- no larger than 108" on any side

Machine Embroidery- no larger than 108" on any side

Mixed Technique- no larger than 108" on any side

Group- no larger than 108" on any side

Youth- no larger than 108" on any side

Wall Quilt- no larger than 60" any side

Contest Rules

1. YOU must determine the category in which your submission will be entered. However, Appleseed Quilters Guild reserves the right to change the category.
2. All persons involved in making the item must be listed on the entry form.
3. An entry form **MUST** accompany each item and must be postmarked by April 1, 2012. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted.
4. Each item to be judged must also include a \$10 non-refundable entry fee.
5. No more than five (5) entries per person will be accepted for the judged portion of the quilt show. No more than eight (8) total entries will be accepted from any one (1) person (does not include Challenge Quilt entry). Appleseed Quilt Show reserves the right to reduce the limit, as required, due to space limitations.
6. All decisions made by the judges are final.
7. Quilts may be constructed by hand, machine, or both. Quilts must be made of three (3) layers (fabric top/batting/fabric backing) and hand-or machine-quilted. Tied quilts will NOT be accepted.
8. Quilts must have been completed **in the last five (5) years and not previously displayed in the Appleseed Quilters Guild Quilt Show.**
9. The Appleseed Quilt Show reserves the right to reject any entry. The Appleseed Quilt Show reserves the right to refuse any quilt that is soiled, damaged in any way and/or has pet hair or an unpleasant odor.
10. All quilts must be permanently identified on the back. A 4-inch sleeve is required on every quilt. To better display and protect quilts that measure 90" or larger, a 4-inch split sleeve is encouraged with the sleeve placed 90" from the bottom of the quilt.

Item Submission Instructions

- Each quilt requires a separate entry form
- Judged entries: Entry fee is \$10 per quilt
- Display Only quilts: No fee required

Hand Delivered Entries

Hand delivered items with a permanent identification on the back will only be accepted at the Memorial Coliseum on Tuesday, June 19, 2012, beginning at 7 am and no later than 9 am.

Shipped Entries

Shipping instructions will be sent via EMAIL if you have included your email address. Include a self-addressed stamped business-size envelope (SASE) if you wish to receive shipping instructions via US mail.

Critical Dates

April 1, 2012	Entry deadline. Entry forms cannot be postmarked later than this date.
June 1, 2012	Shipped entries must arrive at receiving site.
June 19, 2012	Hand-delivered entries will be received at the Memorial Coliseum only on this date, beginning at 7 am and no later than 9 am.
June 23, 2012	All hand-delivered entries are to be picked up after the Quilt Show on Saturday, June 23, 5 - 7 pm. Identification is required.
