100 Nancy Odom Honeysuckle View Machine Applique

Learn about using fusible web to bond appliqué pieces to quilt tops. Nancy will discuss the different types of fusible web on the market today, sharing examples of appliquéd quilts using these products. She will take you step-by-step through her machine appliqué technique, using a machine buttonhole stitch to finish the raw edges of the appliqué pieces. Finished size: 34" x 34". **Intermediate skill levels.**

101 Linda Johnson Here A Chick (Beyond the Block)

This wall hanging was inspired by a delightful chicken fabric, but you could bring any other focus blocks and Linda will help you design your own one-of-a-kind quilt. Learn what fabrics make your motif "pop." You'll also work on some of the supporting blocks included in the pattern, but you may choose different blocks and fillers to complement your chosen fabric in this "design-as-you-go" process. With built-in "fudge-factors," this is practically goof-proof! The sample is a 32" x 30" wall hanging, but you'll have options for different size blocks and smaller or larger finished quilts. **All skill levels.**



102 Carol Vinnedge Abby's Treasure

Looking for a great scrap or charm square project? Or don't know what to do with those popular large-scale prints you just had to buy? This quilt makes great use of all of the above! It is fast and fun and the design can be applied to any size quilt you desire and you'll end up with a "wow" quilt sure to please. 200 Nancy Odom Prairie Picnic

Lemonade and warm summer afternoons are the perfect companions to this picnic quilt. The twelve blocks are strip-pieced with no seams to match up (what could be better?). Sashed together, these blocks make a visually appealing quilt that you'll enjoy using for years to come. Nancy will also teach some basic quick-fuse appliqué techniques for the very small amount of appliqué on this quilt. Finished size: 67" x 85". **All skill levels.**



201 Jane Wells Create a Critter

Any animal can be beautifully depicted in a quilt using this method. During class, students will learn how to make a pattern from a photo, choose fabric to achieve a dimensional look, and begin to actually make their critter. Machine quilting (to be done after class) greatly enhances the quilt. **Skill level:** Confident beginner and up.



202 Jacquie Gering Not Your Grandmother's Log Cabin

Learn how to make the traditional log cabin block and give it a modern twist through improvisation. Choose to make one of several quilts or take the technique where you want to go and make your own version of the modern log cabin quilt. Seven variations of the log cabin block will be shared in class. **All skill levels.**
