Basic sewing and quilting skills are necessary, knowledge of free-motion quilting is a plus.

Description

Join us for an adventure in art quilting! We'll explore techniques to combine technology of basic household equipment, such as a digital camera, computer, printer, and sewing machine to create a breathtaking piece of fiber art worthy of hanging in a gallery.

Materials

Photograph you have taken of a flower, building, landscape (not an animal or human figure). Electronic file on CD is preferred, but a print will work also.

Inner border fabric: dark-value fabric to coordinate with colors in photograph

Outer border fabric: medium- or light-value fabric to coordinate or contrast with colors in photograph

18" x 22" piece of dense fleece (not sweatshirt fleece and not fluffy quilt batting)

Usual sewing supplies

Monofilament thread

Black upholstery thread

Several spools of coordinating and/or contrasting threads
