

Supply List for Stripy Triangles

For each square you need 8" square of fabric. I would suggest purchasing some fat quarter or $\frac{1}{4}$ yard pieces of fabric but go thru your stash and bring a large collection of scraps for triangles and to make some of your 8 " squares. This is a good way of using some of your scraps that you have been saving. You will also need fabric for spacing in between you squares. These will be $6\frac{1}{2}$ " in length but are cut in various widths.

Fabric for borders, 1 yard of medium tone fabric and $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of light one fabric, you might want to wait until you get your strips pieced together to purchase this fabric.

Rotary cutter and board

Sewing Machine

Small scissors

Thread

If you have a small iron you might want to bring it along with a small pressing board (the reversible cutting and ironing boards works well for this class.

8" or 12" square ruler

$6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " or $6\frac{1}{2}$ x 24" ruler

Triangles whatever you have. I like the Quilt in a Day Triangle
