




# FROM THE PRESIDENT

Greetings, Appleseed Quilters!

With this newsletter arriving at the end of November, I find myself still in a Thanksgiving state of mind. Our guild has so much to be grateful for—and at the top of that list is all of **you**. Together, we've shown incredible caring and sharing throughout the years through our many philanthropy projects.

One of our longest-running efforts has been our annual donation of quilts to **Camp Watcha-Wanna-Do**, a tradition that has continued for more than 30 years. For members who may be new to Appleseed, this camp serves children up to age 18 who have been diagnosed with cancer. Whether they are in treatment or post-treatment, each of these young campers has faced more than any child should. Every June, at a camp just north of Fort Wayne, they are given a week filled with fun—made a little brighter by the quilts **we provide**. Each camper chooses a quilt, keeps it with them all week, and then takes it home. This project is truly close to our hearts, and I am proud that we have supported these kids for over three decades.

In addition to the generosity shown through making and donating "Kids Quilts," I am continually thankful for the strong volunteer spirit within our guild. At any given meeting, I see the many faces of members who help our guild run smoothly. When I look at the "Non Board Positions," we routinely have 15 to 20 members stepping up to serve—and that doesn't count the countless others who help in quieter ways.

I know there are even more of you who love quilting and enjoy being involved. If that's you, please let me or any board member know! You can find the list of Board of Directors and Non Board Positions toward the end of this newsletter.

Looking ahead, in January I will be seeking volunteers to help plan an **off-year fundraiser**. Since Quilt Fest is held every two years, the board would like to explore an additional event during the off year. More information will be coming soon.



Let's fill the basket and celebrate the New Year- Appleseed Quilters Guild style!




## Fortune Cookie Instructions

1. Trace the circle on the next page onto a piece of fusible web. Cut out on the line.
2. Place two 6" squares of fabric right sides together.
3. Fuse web circle onto back of one square. Do not remove paper at the time.
4. Shorten your stitch length on your machine so that the stitches will be quite close together.
5. With matching thread, stitch around the outside of the fusible web, close to the web. Leave a 1 ½' opening, making sure to back stitch at the beginning and ending.
6. Trim away the selvage close to the stitching line, approximately 1/8-1/4".
7. Take paper off but DO NOT PRESS.
8. Turn inside out, lifting fusible as needed to smooth. Be careful not to stretch it out of shape, especially the opening.
9. Turn the selvage inside along the opening, making sure the curve looks smooth. DO NOT PRESS.
10. Machine topstitch around the edge of the "cookie" 1/8" from edge, making sure to catch opening selvages inside. PRESS.
11. Fold in half and press firmly to create a crease down the center. Open up and fold in half the other way also. It should be folded into 4 sections. (The inside fabric will become the outside of the "cookie").
12. Stitch down the center of the crease leaving ½" on each end unstitched. Be sure to backstitch. (See illustration on next page).
13. Fold and place "fortune" paper on the side of the cookie along the stitched seam. (See illustration).
14. Flip each curved edge inside out, to form a clamshell shape. Adjust as necessary to make it look like a fortune cookie.


Membership cards are still available at the check-in desk. If I missed you, please reach out to me and I'll have it ready for you at the December meeting.
